Executive Summary:

Oregon State University is submitting this proposal to describe its methodology to attract and retain qualified, graduate students in nuclear related disciplines. The program will be administered by, Dr. Camille Lodwick, an assistant professor in the Department of Nuclear Engineering and Radiation Health Physics. The program will provide eight incoming students with tuition assistance and monthly stipend for their first year pursuing a graduate degree in a nuclear-related discipline. The program will focus on recruiting highly deserving students into the department and will incorporate metrics to track student performance and evaluate program effectiveness. The tenured and tenure-track faculty, as a part of the annual admission process, will jointly select recipients of the OSU Nuclear Fellowship.
