Executive Summary: Columbia Basin College (CBC) in partnership with local Nuclear Industry leaders requests funding to develop a comprehensive outreach and recruitment strategy for the Nuclear Technology (NT) program. Together with the CBC Nuclear Technology Advisory Committee, CBC has identified the need to increase the number of underrepresented minority students pursuing degrees that lead to careers in the nuclear industry. The CBC Outreach and Retention Program (ORP) will enhance Nuclear Technology awareness in the K-12 system as well as develop new programming and outreach materials specific to the nuclear industry.
