Executive Summary

The purpose of this proposal is to expand its On-Campus Student Employment Program. This program is to provide University of Texas El Paso students with meaningful on-campus employment in areas that directly contribute to their career objectives and/or support their successful progress towards degree completion.

Over the past two years, the program employed over 200 students in research labs, tutoring centers and academic support areas. Typically, students work alongside a professor as a research or lab assistant. This valuable on-the-job training provides each student participant with greater exposure to his or her area of academic interest and facilitates a mentoring opportunity between the student and the professor/staff member.
