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Eprescribing Activities Related to SCRIPT usage

- May 2007 LTC industry participants request removal of exemption from eprescribing and use of SCRIPT version 10.1
- Eprescribing participants discuss and build recommendation moving to a new version of SCRIPT on November 8, 2007 during NCPDP quarterly work group meetings
- November 16, 2007 CMS releases NPRM on eprescribing
- December 17, 2007 NCPDP submits recommendation letter to NCVHS



Recommendations Submitted

- NCVHS recommend to CMS the use of NCPDP SCRIPT version 10.5 with implementation date of January 2010
 - Ambulatory and LTC use
- Continue support of SCRIPT version 8.1
 - dual versions supported (8.1 and 10.5)
 - Can co-exist
 - Now supporting 5.0 and 8.1, but predominant use of 8.1
- Sunset SCRIPT version 5.0



SCRIPT version 10.5

- Under ballot (January 2008)
- Ballot Adjudication (February 2008)
- If ballot comments, anticipated recirculation ballot (April 2008)
- Discussion of recirculation comments (May 2008)
- Appeal timeframe (June 2008)
- NCPDP Board of Trustees approval (July 2008)
- Publication (July 2008)



SCRIPT Enhancements

- Detailed changes are included in every version of SCRIPT (Appendix B. History of Implementation Guide Changes)
- Summary provided to NCVHS as attachment to the December letter



- Approved October 2005
- Quantity Qualifier with values for units and purpose - removed units; was causing confusion



- Approved October 2006
- Long term care needs
 - Patient identifier qualifier additional values
 - Date additional values
 - Prior Authorization Status with values
 - Do Not Fill/Profile Flag
 - Facility Unit, Room, Bed
 - Cancel message Change of Prescription Status Flag for discontinue open refills or not yet dispensed values



- Approved July 2007
- Long term care needs
 - CENSUS Update Transaction added
 - Facility notifies the pharmacy about new resident/change to demographic info/discharge of resident
 - Resupply Request Transaction added
 - Looks like a Refill Request, but no response is necessary
- Other needs
 - Prescriber Order Number added in Medication History



- Approved July 2007
- Long term care needs
 - Needed No Later Than date/time added for special delivery needs



- Approval anticipated April 2008
- Medication History Source and Fill Number information for de-duplicate processing



- Approval anticipated April 2008
- Support of multiple pharmacy benefit identifiers (BIN/Processor Control Number)
- Support of Sig Segment for patient instructions
 - Based on the Structured & Codified Sig Format Implementation Guide
 - For future piloter's use



- Approval anticipated July 2008
- Support of XML incorporated into imp guide
- Support of HITSP recommendations for Medication Management Use Case
 - Support of Federal Medication Terminologies code sets
 - Further constraints identified by HITSP
