- Available to Fee for Service beneficiaries in South Carolina.
 - Initial target population size = 100k.
 - All Fee for Service beneficiaries in SC are eligible = 660,000.
- Provides 24 months of Medicare A and B claims history upon request.
- Provides 24 months of TRICARE for Life pharmacy data upon request.
- Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week through the internet.
- Project team.

- Launched 4/7/08.

Pilot Project – Requirements Use an existing PHR. Claims data is pre-populated into the record.

- ICD 9 Coding data is translated into easy to understand language.
- Beneficiaries have the ability to add information, but not change their data.
- Meets CMS security standards.
- Implement a comprehensive Outreach Plan.

SNOMED – As a Means to Ensure Privacy

- SNOMED coding provides a mechanism to tie together data that is otherwise unrelated.
- SNOMED (e.g., tying unrelated data together) allows for the creation of Sensitive Data Categories.
- The PHR default setting hides restricted data classes and restricted functional areas.
 - Many non-clinical people do not know what information in their PHR is related to conditions they would like to keep private. Suppressing the data provides a much higher level of privacy for the beneficiary.
 - Users can allow trusted members of their health care team, family or people they trust to have access to their Personal Health Record (e.g., Authorized Representatives).
