PURPOSE:

On November 8, 2012, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC, the Commission) approved a Memorandum and Order (CLI-12-20) to address the intervention petition (SECY-12-0117), where Friends of the Earth (FOE) argued that Southern California Edison (SCE) violated Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) Section 50.59 when the steam generators for San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3, were replaced in 2010 and 2011 without a license amendment. FOE requested a hearing on its 10 CFR 50.59 claim, and asked that its petition not be construed as a request for enforcement relief under 10 CFR 2.206. In a subsequent submittal, FOE stated that the 10 CFR 2.206 process was not a "viable alternative" for obtaining relief. The Commission disagreed and referred this portion of FOE's petition to the Executive Director for Operations (EDO) for consideration as a petition under 10 CFR 2.206. The purpose of this meeting is to provide the petitioner with an opportunity to address the

NRC Petition Review Board (PRB), pursuant to 10 CFR 2.206.
