Monitoring Panel Observations

- Adherence to the guidance varies across the pilot plants in how the panels are conducted
- The scope of information brought to the panel varies between the pilot plants



Site Leadership Meeting Observations

- Threshold for discussing an item in the meeting is not consistent
- Believe that it is positive to such a diverse group looking at site safety culture on a periodic basis

Miscellaneous Observations

- There is variation in the process between sites
- Threshold for identifying items for inclusion in the process varies
- Process is not transparent to the public
- Benchmarking implementation between the pilot sites may have provided valuable insights
- Based on the processes that already exist at some sites, some plants derive a great benefit from the process and some derive an incremental benefit
