Critical Infrastructure Partnership

• Established by the Department of Homeland Security to facilitate effective coordination between Federal State, Local, Territorial and Tribal governments and Private Sector infrastructure protection programs.

 The CIPAC represents a partnership between government and critical infrastructure/key resource (CIKR) owners and operators and provides a forum in which they can engage in a broad spectrum of activities to support and coordinate critical infrastructure protection.

 CIPAC activities in the NIPP partnership framework are exempt from the requirements of the Federal Advisory Committee Act. This enables meaningful dialogue on key critical infrastructure protection issues and agreement on mutual action between Government and owners/operators.
