## What's New in Formulas Online 1.2 (Industry Members)

September 8, 2012

The following system updates and new functionality are included in Version 1.2 of the Formulas Online system:

- **Browser Compatibility Updates** You may now submit submissions in the Formulas Online system through the following browsers:
  - o Apple Safari (version 5.1 or higher)
  - o Google Chrome (version 21.0 or higher)
  - o Microsoft Internet Explorer (version 7 or higher)
  - o Mozilla Firefox (version 15.0 or higher)

In addition, Formulas Online displays properly in Internet Explorer version 8 or higher, so there is no longer any need to enable Compatibility View when working in Internet Explorer. When using other browsers you may notice some pages do not look the same as they do when using Internet Explorer. We will continue to work on these "cosmetic" issues, but Formulas Online does function properly in all of the previously mentioned compatible browsers. We still recommend you use Internet Explorer (version 7 or higher) on a Windows operating system for the best system performance.

• Cancellation of Daily System Maintenance – The Formulas Online system is no longer unavailable daily from 10 a.m. ET to 10:15 a.m. ET for system maintenance. This daily system maintenance has been cancelled and you no longer need to save your work-in-progress and log off Formulas Online before this time period.


#### Retracted Daily System Maintenance Message in TTB Online Portal Page

Beginning on <u>April 24, 2012</u>, Formulas Online will be unavailable <u>daily</u> from <u>10 a.m. ET</u> to <u>10:15 a.m. ET</u> for system maintenance. Please make sure to save any work-in-progress and log off the Formulas Online application before this daily outage begins. An announcement will be posted once this daily maintenance is cancelled.

• Unlock Locked Account Through New or Forgotten Password? Link – You may now unlock your user account if you lock it during a failed login attempt by setting a new password through the New or Forgotten Password? link in the TTB Online Portal page. You will need your user name, registered email address, and authentication question answers to complete the process.



#### **Unlock Locked Account**





You will need your user name, registered email address, and authentication question answers to complete the process.

• **Process User Registration Within 20 Days** – You may now allow up to 20 days for a User Registration to process. Previously, the User Registration could take up to 30 days to process. The submission confirmation message still states 30 days, but this message will be updated in a future release of Formulas Online.

- Round Calculated Drawback Totals to 3 Decimal Places The Formulas Online system now rounds all calculated Drawback total fields to no less than 3 decimal places.
- View Formulas Online Links in New Tabs It is recommended that you navigate Formulas Online using the available links in the application (i.e., Home, My Submissions) and not through your web browser navigational controls (i.e., Back button, History). However, if you wish to navigate between areas of the application without using these existing links (such as viewing a submission and then returning to your My Submissions page without selecting the Home link), you may open links in new tabs by pressing the CTRL key and selecting the link. Opening links in new tabs will display information concurrently, allowing you to toggle back and forth between the tabs and view/review information within them.
