Effective immediately, IS292 Disaster Basics is removed from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Independent Study website and the FEKC (FEMA Employee Knowledge Center). This training is no longer required. The following training is required for FEMA and non-FEMA staffs as indicated below.

FEMA Employees:

The replacement courses are: IS101 - Deployment Basics: Federal Disaster Workforce Readiness IS800.b - National Response Framework: An Introduction

Both are located at <u>http://training.fema.gov/IS/</u>. Select ISP course list from the red box on the upper left hand side and scroll down until you find the required courses. IS101 is also still located in the FEKC (FEMA Employee Knowledge Center)

IS101: This course is designed to help prepare FEMA employees for deployment to a domestic incident. In recent years, we have witnessed the destruction that can be caused by the forces of nature, or precipitated by terrorist or criminal acts. Course Objectives include:

- Check in when you arrive at your assigned location.
- Acclimate to the working and living conditions at the Joint Field Office.
- Take care of yourself during deployment.
- Maintain standards for accountability.
- Complete the check-out process.

These courses serve as pre-requisites to E/L292 (Disaster Field Operations Management).
