The roundtable, which took place in June 2008, focused on the following:

- Understanding the mutual responsibilities for preparing and responding to radiation incidents
- Strengthening communication and improving working relationships among participating organizations
- Sharing information on available resources
- Increasing awareness of emerging roles and responsibilities in a radiation incident

The report details this roundtable's proceedings and conclusions, and provides materials utilized during the roundtable, as well as comments/suggestions and a list of attendees. The document was developed by a working group within CRCPD.
