Subj: Department of Navy Implementation and Transition to

the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) Electronic Questionnaires for Investigations Processing (e-QIP)

1. By October 1, 2009, the Department of the Navy (DON) will transition to the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) Electronic Questionnaires for Investigations Processing (e-QIP) for processing the Standard Form (SF) 85 and SF-85 Public Trust.

- 2. The DON JPAS/JCAVS Program Manager, Ms. Shirley Maddox-Stubbs, is responsible for the implementation, oversight, and required e-QIP training for all Echelon II Security Managers. After the Echelon II Security Manager is trained on the new process, training of subordinate security managers will be based on "train the trainer" concept. Dates for training will be sent via separate cover.
- 3. On July 23, 2009 this office sent out the initial e-mail request for a copy of your organizational chart. As of today, input has been received from the following commands:
