ADOB SDOTLIGHT

All prime contractors are required to be registered in the <u>System for Award Management</u> (SAM) to conduct business with the Federal Government. CAGE codes for entities located outside the United States and its territories are called NCAGE codes. Assignment of NCAGE codes are governed internationally as part of the NATO Codification System (NCS). NCAGE codes are required for all foreign entities or the registration will be considered incomplete. Information on how to obtain NCAGE codes may be found at: http://www.dlis.dla.mil/Forms/Form AC135.asp. The banking information is mandatory for U.S. registrants in SAM but is optional for foreign registrants.

<u>Acquisition Tracking System (ATS)</u>: "N/A" has been added to the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) menu and should be used when a COR is not applicable.
