tea made of marijuana soaked in denatured alcohol. The nominator questions whether

the marijuana tea therapy has ever been investigated.

Key QuestionsHow effective are copper and marijuana tea for relieving arthritis pain?
Has the use of marijuana tea to relieve arthritis pain been investigated?
