Results of Topic Selection Process & Next Steps

Genetic testing is too broad a topic to develop with limited program resources, given the lack of defined conditions or tests of interest. No further activity will be undertaken on this topic.

Topic Description

Nominator: Public payer

Nomination Summary:

The nominator states that there is a large amount of uncertainty and practice variation related to the use of genetic tests. They question which genetic tests demand a clinical

intervention.

Key Questions from Nominator:

1. Based on current science (this is a moving target), which genetic tests demand a clinical therapeutic intervention?

Considerations

■ This topic could not be evaluated due to insufficient information given in the original nomination. Further feedback from the nominator indicated that they were unable to limit the conditions and tests of interest. After further consideration, the nominator withdrew their nomination, stating that an EHC Program product would not be a good fit with their programmatic needs.
