

### Information Sheet – May 2011

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) is an Agency within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. As the Nation's Access Agency, HRSA focuses on uninsured, underserved, and special needs populations. The HRSA Data Warehouse provides a single point of access to **current** HRSA information, health resources, and demographic data for reporting on HRSA activities. The Data Warehouse is available on the Internet at <http://datawarehouse.hrsa.gov>.

The Data Warehouse promotes information sharing and collaboration among HRSA staff, HRSA partners, health planners and policy makers, as well as HRSA stakeholders. It provides quick access to information that includes:

- Find A Health Center - includes search-by address capabilities, maps and driving directions;
- Find National Health Service Corps Job Opportunities;
- Identify HRSA Grants by Key Program Area or State;
- Determine whether an address is located in a Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA);
- Determine whether an address is located in a HPSA that is eligible for Medicare Physician Bonus Payments;
- Determine whether an address is located in a Medically Underserved Area or Population (MUA/P);
- View and print from a Map Gallery that includes pre-formatted maps of Grants, Health Care Service Delivery Sites, HPSAs, and the National Health Service Corps (NHSC).

Supplementing the interactive online reporting capability and tools built into the Data Warehouse, you can connect to the data for use in your own applications. You can access or obtain data via:

- XML-based web data services that can be used to include data from the Data Warehouse into your own applications and custom tools.

In addition, the Data Warehouse provides quick access and the ability to explore data and maps that include:



**Charts** – view performance indicators that connect to regularly refreshed data sources and provide at-a-glance information on important metrics, assisting in decision making;



**Maps** – visually explore HRSA-specific information, health resources and demographic data in geographic relation to one another;



**Reports** – output traditional text-based reporting of the data available in the Data Warehouse. Users can select, sort, export and view the data either by spreadsheet or preformatted reports;



**Tables** – on-screen summary tables of key HRSA activities; and



**Tools** – search or sort data in a variety of useful ways, with as much simplicity or interactivity as needed

The Data Warehouse offers widgets that provide quick, easy ways for other websites to connect users to related Data Warehouse tools and capabilities.

HRSA Data Warehouse news and updates are available through RSS feeds, which deliver news about updates and changes to your desktop, email client, mobile device, or web browser.
