

Handgun Safety





SAFE USE OF A FIREARM IS YOUR PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY AND THE FAILURE TO FOLLOW BASIC SAFETY RULES MAY RESULT IN SEVERE PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH.

Basic Handgun Safety Rules:

- 1. Treat ALL firearms as if they were loaded.
- 2. DO NOT point at or cover anything with the muzzle until ready to shoot.
- 3. Keep trigger finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until ready to shoot.
- 4. Be certain of your target and your line of fire.

Safe and secure storage of your firearm is one of your most important responsibilities. It is a full-time responsibility. You must always secure your firearm and ammunition so that they are not accessible to children or other unauthorized persons.

If you own a weapon you must register in accordance with Fort Stewart Regulation 190-2. Weapon registration is required just like vehicle registration on Fort Stewart. http://www.stewart.army.mil/des/gateInfoVehReg.asp
