



New York-Northern New Jersey-Long Island, NY-NJ

- In 2011, the New York metropolitan area was the largest export market in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$105.1 billion. This is up \$20.0 billion (23.5 percent) from the \$85.1 billion in merchandise exported in 2010.
- For the top 50 U.S. merchandise export destinations, New York ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters to Canada (\$11.6 billion), Hong Kong (\$8.4 billion), the United Kingdom (\$5.8 billion), Israel (\$5.5 billion), and Switzerland (\$5.5 billion).
- New York ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters of Miscellaneous Manufactured Commodities (\$20.5 billion), Chemicals (\$17.4 billion), Primary Metal Manufacturing (\$9.7 billion), Petroleum and Coal Products (\$5.9 billion), and Crop Production (\$5.3 billion).
- In 2011, New York benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting \$16.8 billion to the NAFTA region and \$1.1 billion to the CAFTA-DR region.
- 15.9 percent of New York's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
