2 U.S. Pilots Win Acquittal In Taipei Trial on '68 Crash

TAIPEI, Taiwan, Jan. 20 (AP)— The Taipei District Court today acquitted two American

today acquitted two American pilots charged with criminal re-sponsibility for the crash of a Civil Air Transport airliner near Taipei in February 1968. The pilots are Capt. Stuart E. Dew, 46, of Hamburg, Ark., and Capt. Hugh H. Hicks, 51, of Hannibal, Ohio. Captain Hicks' wife, also an American, was one of the 22 persons killed in the crash of the Boe-ing 727 jetliner. It could not be learned im-mediately whether the prosecu-tor, Hsa Chen-chih, would ap-peal the acquittal, which is possible under Chinese law.
