IN SUMMARY I THINK THE FOLLOWING POINTS ARE NOTEWORTHY AND COULD HAVE HAD DISASTEROUS RESULTS:

- 1. THE AAM COMPOUND WAS NOT SECURED, LOCKED OR GUARDED.
- 2. THE AAM RAMP HAD NO SECURITY,
- 3. THE SO1 AND EVACUATION INSTRUCTION PACKET WAS NOT DISTRIBUTED IN ADVANCE SO THE PILOTS COULD BE FAMILIAR WITH THE CONTENTS. SEVERAL INCLUDING MYSELF DID NOT GET ONE.
- 4. THE POL TRUCK AT DAO WAS NOT IN OPERATING CONDITION.
- 5. THE 205S HAD INADEQUATE COMMUNICATION TO WORK SAFELY. MUCH INSTALLED DID NOT WORK.
- 6. PROVISIONS NOT MADE TO TAKE CARE OF BAGGAGE IN OPERATIONS.
