"iournalist": A 28 June message from Sukharev, a Soviet adviser to the North
Korean airforce, which was to be passed to Razuvaev, chief adviser at Supreme
Headquarters, states: "A group of Korean journalists (has arrived?). Urgently
(send?) 2 trucks." (SUEDE, AFSA-23AA/70A/KC/TIB-13, 23 Aug 51).

Comment: Razuvaev is also the new Soviet Ambassador to North Korea.
While this message is of no particular importance as it stands, it may be
speculated that the term "journalist" is a cover name for Koreans who have
received some form of specialized training either in Manchuria or in the USSR.
In this connection recent covert reports have alleged the return of a number
of Korean pilots who have received aircraft training in the USSR.
