Scope and Content Note

The papers of the Mercy-Argenteau family span the years 1410-1921 and consist of correspondence, commissions, diplomas, certificates, and other documents. Included are military papers relating to the Silesian War and Seven Years' War, letters from King Leopold II of Austria, and material relating to California and Mexico. The material is in Dutch, French, German, Latin, and Spanish.

The collection is organized by type of material largely as received, with overlapping between folders or groups of chronological files and oversize items at the end.
