1. ORIGINATING SERVICE/AGENCY AND POC INFORMATION:

- **a. Technical POC:** Navy Supply Process Review Committee (SPRC) representative on behalf of Navy ERP, NAVSUP E4, DSN 430-7510, commercial (717) 605-7510
- **b. Functional POC:** Navy SPRC representative on behalf of Navy ERP, NAVSUP E4, DSN 430-7510, commercial (717) 605-7510
- 2. FUNCTIONAL AREA: Primary/Secondary Functional Area: Supply

3. BACKGROUND:

- **a. Intent of the transaction:** Organizations use this transaction set to refer a requisition to another organization.
- **b. Scenario for which the transaction is used:** Referring a requisition to an inventory manager.
- c. Procedures, transactions, data elements, processing details in use today: Legacy Navy systems refer requisitions to the Navy Inventory Control Point (ICP) when the requisition cannot be filled by the referring system. The management code is used by the Navy to indicate the reason the requisition is being referred to the ICP.
- **4. PROPOSED CHANGE(S):** Revisions which are highlighted in green were identified subsequent to staffing.
 - a. Revise DS 511R, Requisition, as shown in Change Table Below:

c. Alternatives: None identified.

5. REASON FOR CHANGE: Navy modernized system development is being programmed to be DLMS compliant. The legacy systems DI Code A4A Management Code needs to be mapped to the 511R/Requisition transaction.

6. ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES:

a. Advantages (tangible/intangible): Allows development of only a DLMS compliant solution for the 511R functionality.

b. Disadvantages: None.

7. ESTIMATED TIME LINE/IMPLEMENTATION TARGET: Expected implementation date is April, 2010.

8. IMPACT:

a. DAASC mapping. DAASC translate Navy management code on Document Identifier A4_ transactions to DLMS 511R transactions when sending them to a DLMS compliant Navy system. Revise DAASC MILS to DLMS mapping applicable to Document Identifier A4_ record position (RP) 72 as follows¹:
