  - Term-limited appointment for up to 4 years
  - Must meet medical standards & have or be eligible for a clearance
- Benefits include base GS salary plus:
  - 35% differential for hazardous duty
  - 35% differential for post differential
  - Significant Overtime Compensation
  - Health Insurance and Life Insurance

  - Being part of a larger mission
