The purpose of this amendment to RFP NIDCR-DR-04-15, is to (1) revise the Request for Proposals and (2) provide NHLBI responses to questions from potential offerors.

- (1) On page 7, the last sentence of bullet 1 of paragraph 1 of Task 3 is revised to read "Identify problems in adhering to the details of the protocol and help solve these problems promptly."
- (2) The following questions and responses are provided as clarification for RFP: NIDCR-DR-04-15:

Question a.	How often and how long is drug applied by the subject? Please clarify the total treatment duration.

- Response: The drug will be applied 4 times per day for up to 4 weeks or until ulcer is healed, which ever occurs earliest.
- Question b. Will the NIH Pharmacy directly ship the study drug to each clinical center?
- Response: The NIH Pharmacy will ship drugs directly to the clinical sites based on the randomization given for a particular patient by the coordinating center.
