Implementation of the 2003 U.S. Standard Certificate of Live Birth (revised) by the states and independent reporting areas is being phased in over several years. The 2003 Revision of the U.S. Standard Certificate of live birth introduced substantial changes to data content and quality. Key items such as month prenatal care began, although collected on both certificate revisions, were substantively modified. Changes in how prenatal care information is collected have resulted in a lack of comparability (both over time and between states) between prenatal care data from the 2003 and 1989 Revisions of the U.S. Standard Certificate of Live Birth.
