SBA:

Goaling Achievement
The Department of Treasury (Treasury) met 2 of their 5 prime contracting goals missing Small Business, Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business, and HUBZone.

Fiscal year 2009 prime contracting achievement saw increases over FY2008 in Women Owned Small Business, Small Disadvantaged Business, Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business, and HUBZone. Treasury FY2009 achievement declined from FY2008 for Small Business.
