Graded Agency:

Under Public Law 109-461, the priority of sources for VA procurements puts Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB) first and Veteran Owned Small Businesses (VOSB) second and ahead of all the other small business categories. While this gives VA an advantage in meeting the SDVOSB statutory goal, it makes achievement of the Woman Owned Small Business goal and the HUBZone goal extremely challenging for VA.

SBA:

Goaling Achievement

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) met 3 of their 5 prime contracting goals missing Women Owned Small Business and HUBZone.

Fiscal year 2009 prime contracting achievement saw increases over FY2008 in Small Disadvantaged Business and Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business. VA FY2009 achievement declined for Small Business, Women Owned Small Business, and HUBZone.

SBA Data Anomaly Reports

VA responded late to SBA's contracting data anomaly report and partially addressed submitted anomalies.

Partnership with SBA

VA regularly attended the SBA chaired Small Business Procurement Advisory Council meetings hosted at the SBA.

VA contributes to the Interagency Task Force on Federal Contracting Opportunities for Small Businesses as an executive committee member.

American Reinvestment and Recovery Act Contracts

Since enactment of ARRA, VA has directed 83.9% of their Recovery Act funds toward small businesses.
