SPEAKER BIOGRAPHIES:

Don D'Onofrio is retired from the National Geodetic Survey (NGS) and former State Geodetic Advisor to California and Alaska. Don began his career with the Coast and Geodetic Survey (C&GS) in 1960 and retired from the National Geodetic Survey (NGS) in 1999. During his thirty-nine year career, Don spent time performing satellite positioning surveys at various locations around North America and the world. Don served as the State Geodetic Advisor to Alaska for nearly nine years and as the State Geodetic Advisor to California for nearly ten years. After retirement, Don helped establish the California Spatial Reference Center (CSRC) and helped direct numerous GPS Height Modernization and land subsidence surveys.

Steven J. Martin, PLS is currently the Survey Supervisor for the East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) in Oakland, California. Steve's survey career began in 1988 for the City of San Diego. Prior to assuming his supervisory position at EBMUD, Steve was employed at the County of San Diego where he developed professionally and progressed through increasingly responsible positions over seventeen years of service. Steve has been a licensed California Professional Land Surveyor since 1996 and a member of the California Land Surveyors Association since 1990 where he has served as a Board of Director representing the East Bay Chapter, Chairman of the Education Foundation, and the CLSA liaison to the California Spatial Reference Center (CSRC).

Marti E. Ikehara is currently the State Geodetic Advisor with National Geodetic Survey (NGS). The NGS is an agency within the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) . Marti has been the California Geodetic Advisor since 1999, and advises Caltrans survey staff and many other customers, including environmental restoration scientists throughout the state. Prior to her service in California, she spent the previous twenty years as a ground-water hydrologist with the United States Geological Survey (USGS) working in their offices in Honolulu and Sacramento.
