

If you knowingly mail items or materials that are dangerous or injurious to life, health, or property in violation of 39 USC § 3018 and 18 USC § 1716, you may be liable for:

- A civil penalty of at least $\$ 250$, but not more than \$100,000 per violation.
- The costs of any cleanup associated with each violation.
- Damages.
- Criminal penalties.

Note: Some hazardous materials are mailable when Postal Service ${ }^{\text {TTM }}$ requirements specified in the following documents are satisfied:

- Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual
- Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, International Mail Manual
- Publication 52, Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail.
