If you are importing wood products regulated by 7 CFR 319.40, you must also complete PPQ Form 585. If you are importing plant material for planting, you must also complete PPQ Form 587.

1. Enter the person's name and U.S. street address (and mailing address, if it differs from the street address) who will be responsible for the activities associated with this permit for the validity (2 years).
