ORDER INSTITUTING ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AND NOTICE OF HEARING PURSUANT TO SECTION 12(j) OF THE SECURITIES EXCHANGE ACT OF 1934

I.

The Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") deems it necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors that public administrative proceedings be, and hereby are, instituted pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ("Exchange Act").

II.

After an investigation, the Division of Enforcement alleges that:

A. RESPONDENTS

1. Enamelon, Inc. ("ENML")¹ (CIK 910168) is a Delaware corporation located in Cranbury, New Jersey with common stock registered with the Commission under Exchange Act Section 12(g). ENML is delinquent in its periodic filings, having last filed a periodic report for the period ending December 31, 1999. ENML reported assets of \$7,419,438, liabilities of \$8,059,498, and a net loss of \$18,833,889 for the year ending December 31, 1999. On July 14, 2000, certain of ENML's creditors filed an involuntary bankruptcy petiton against the company under Chapter 7 in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey. ENML later consented to the conversion of this petition into a voluntary petition under Chapter 11. The bankruptcy proceeding terminated on December 11, 2002 and resulted in ENML's liquidation. ENML's common stock was quoted on the Pink Sheets as of August 26, 2005. For the

six months ending March 25, 2005, ENML had an average daily trading volume of 8,671 shares.

- 2. Paracelsian, Inc. ("PRLN") (CIK 882362) is a Delaware corporation located in Ithaca, New York with common stock registered with the Commission under Exchange Act Section 12(g). PRLN is delinquent in its periodic filings, having last filed a periodic report for the period ending June 30, 2002, and has a void status with the Secretary of State of Delaware. PRLN reported assets of \$154,144, liabilities of \$2,154,118, and a net loss of \$406,174 for the nine months ending June 30, 2002. PRLN's common stock was quoted on the Pink Sheets as of August 26, 2005. For the six months ending March 25, 2005, PRLN had an average daily trading volume of 10,795 shares.
- 3. Semiconductor Laser International Corp. ("SLIC") (CIK 921445) is a Delaware corporation located in Binghamton, New York with common stock registered with the Commission under Exchange Act Section 12(g). SLIC is delinquent in its periodic filings, having last filed a periodic report for the period ending September 30, 2000. SLIC reported assets of \$6,151,116, liabilities of \$2,422,157, and a net loss of \$3,453,734 for the nine months ending September 30, 2000. On October 18, 2001, SLIC filed for bankruptcy under Chapter 11 in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of New York. The bankruptcy proceeding resulted in the sale of substantially all of SLIC's assets and the termination of its business operations on March 31, 2003. The bankruptcy proceeding was terminated on October 28, 2003. SLIC's common stock was quoted on the Pink Sheets as of August 26, 2005. For the six months ending March 25, 2005, SLIC had an average daily trading volume of 6,374 shares.
- 4. Socrates Technologies Corp. ("SOCT") (CIK 937603) is a Delaware corporation located in Gainesville, Virginia with common stock registered with the Commission under Exchange Act Section 12(g). SOCT is delinquent in its periodic filings, having last filed a periodic report for the period ending September 30, 2000, and has a forfeited status with the Secretary of State of Delaware. SOCT reported assets of \$3,982,000, liabilities of \$6,718,000, and a net loss of \$16,269,000 for the nine months ending September 30, 2000. On October 15, 2001, SOCT filed for bankruptcy under Chapter 7 in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia. The bankruptcy proceeding terminated on December 18, 2001. SOCT's common stock was quoted on the Pink Sheets as of August 26, 2005. For the six months ending March 25, 2005, SOCT had an average daily trading volume of 18,276 shares.
- 5. Star Technologies, Inc. ("STRR") (CIK 733871) is a Delaware corporation located in Dulles, Virginia with common stock registered with the Commission under Exchange Act Section 12(g). STRR is delinquent in its periodic filings, having last filed a periodic report for the period ending September 30, 1999, which places it in violation of a Commission order against it in *Star Technologies, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. File No. 3-8228, Exchange Act Rel. No. 33198 (Nov. 15, 1993), which, among other things, ordered that it cease and desist from future violations of Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder. STRR also has a void status with the Secretary of State of Delaware. STRR reported assets of \$3,501,000, liabilities

of \$4,090,000, and a net loss of \$1,903,000 for the nine months ending September 30, 1999. STRR's common stock was quoted on the Pink Sheets as of August 26, 2005. For the six months ending March 25, 2005, STRR had an average daily trading volume of 11,651 shares.

- 6. Telemonde, Inc. ("TLMD") (CIK 1098387) is a Delaware corporation located in New York, New York with common stock registered with the Commission under Exchange Act Section 12(g). TLMD is delinquent in its periodic filings, having last filed a periodic report for the period ending June 30, 2002, and has a void status with the Secretary of State of Delaware. TLMD reported assets of \$428,000, liabilities of \$121,028,000, and a net loss of \$1,058,000 for the six months ending June 30, 2002. TLMD's common stock was quoted on the Pink Sheets as of August 26, 2005. For the six months ending March 25, 2005, TLMD had an average daily trading volume of 31,063 shares.
- 7. VDC Communications, Inc. ("VDCI") (CIK 784961) is a Delaware corporation located in Newark, New Jersey with common stock registered with the Commission under Exchange Act Section 12(g). VDCI is delinquent in its periodic filings, having last filed a periodic report for the period ending March 31, 2001, and has a void status with the Secretary of State of Delaware. VDCI reported assets of \$3,789,540, liabilities of \$5,309,124, and a net loss of \$7,644,914 for the nine months ending March 31, 2001. VDCI's common stock was quoted on the Pink Sheets as of August 26, 2005. For the six months ending March 25, 2005, VDCI had an average daily trading volume of 8,112 shares.

B. DELINQUENT PERIODIC FILINGS

- 8. This case concerns seven companies with classes of securities registered with the Commission that are delinquent in their periodic reports with the Commission (*see* Chart of Delinquent Filings, attached hereto as Appendix 1). These registrants have the following facts in common. First, they are all Delaware corporations that have been delinquent in their periodic filing obligations with the Commission for at least 32 months. Second, all have registered securities that are quoted on the Pink Sheets. Third, they are all located in the Northeastern United States.
- 9. Exchange Act Section 13(a) and the rules promulgated thereunder require issuers with classes of securities registered pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12 to file with the Commission current and accurate information in periodic reports, even if the registration is voluntary under Section 12(g). Specifically, Rule 13a-1 requires issuers to file annual reports (Forms 10-K or 10-KSB), and Rule 13a-13 requires issuers to file quarterly reports (Forms 10-Q or 10-QSB).
- 10. As a result of the foregoing, the Respondents failed to comply with Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder.

III.

In view of the allegations made by the Division of Enforcement, the Commission deems it necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors to institute public administrative proceedings to determine:

- A. Whether the allegations in Section II are true and, in connection therewith, to afford the Respondents an opportunity to establish any defenses to such allegations; and,
- B. Whether it is necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors to suspend for a period not exceeding twelve months, or revoke the registration of each class of securities of the Respondents identified in Section II registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Exchange Act.

IV.

IT IS ORDERED that a public hearing for the purpose of taking evidence on the questions set forth in Section III hereof shall be convened at a time and place to be fixed, and before an Administrative Law Judge to be designated by further order as provided by Rule 110 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.110].

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondents shall file Answers to the allegations contained in this Order within ten (10) days after service of this Order, as provided by Rule 220 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.220].

If Respondents fail to file the directed Answers, or fail to appear at a hearing after being duly notified, the Respondents may be deemed in default and the proceedings may be determined against them upon consideration of this Order, the allegations of which may be deemed to be true as provided by Rules 155(a), 220(f), 221(f) and 310 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), 201.220(f), 201.221(f), and 201.310].

This Order shall be served forthwith upon Respondents personally or by certified mail.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge shall issue an initial decision not later than 120 days from the date of service of this Order, pursuant to Rule 360(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.360(a)(2)].

In the absence of an appropriate waiver, no officer or employee of the Commission engaged in the performance of investigative or prosecuting functions in this or any factually related proceeding will be permitted to participate or advise in the decision of this matter, except as witness or counsel in proceedings held pursuant to notice. Since this proceeding is not "rule making" within the meaning of Section 551 of the Administrative Procedure Act, it is not deemed subject to the provisions of Section 553 delaying the effective date of any final Commission action.
