

Helping Underinsured Patients

Patient Access Network helps commercially and federally insured patients with copayment obligations associated with their healthcare treatments. In just six years, Patient Access Network has helped over 80,000 patients by providing nearly \$119 million in financial assistance.

For underinsured patients it is nearly impossible to pay for life-saving medications without PAN's assistance. PAN's impact is best reflected in the countless stories from patients who report that receiving assistance from PAN has reduced their stress, increased their physical activity and improved their quality of life. Our patient Mark from North Carolina told us, "Living on a fixed income I really had a problem, because I take 16 different drugs a day." For many patients like Mark, just a little assistance makes the difference between the healthy life each patient deserves and one of uncertainty about the future.

PAN provides individual grants of \$1,500 to \$10,000 annually to cover co-payments, deductibles, and co-insurance for underinsured patients.
