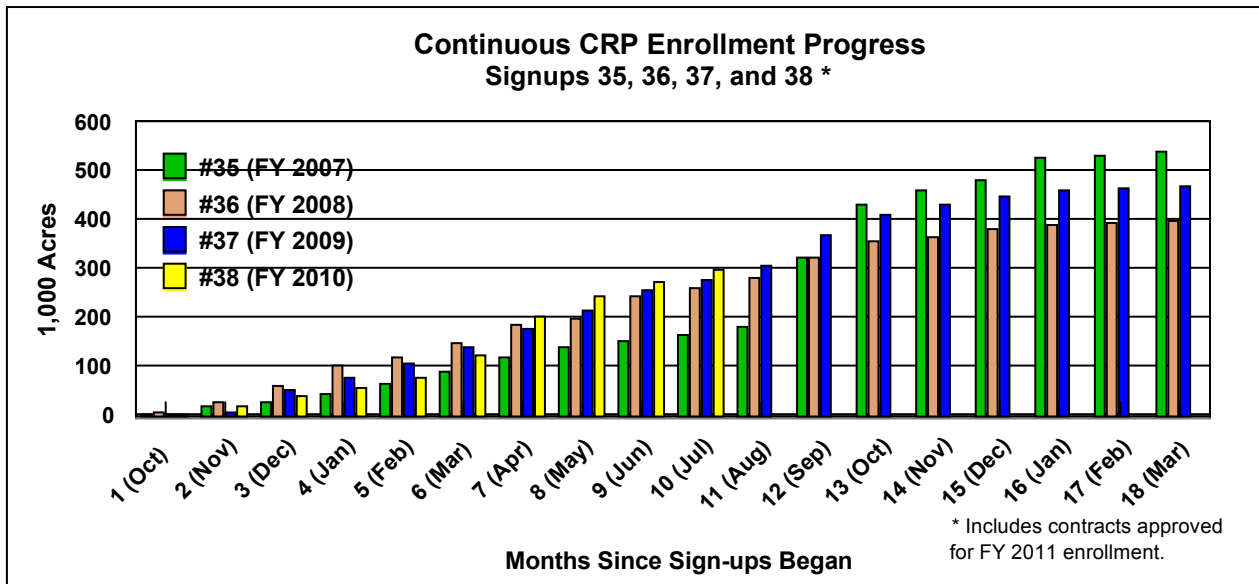

## ***CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – July 2010***

- There are now 83,960 acres of signup 38 contracts approved for FY 2011 enrollment (p. 3). This complicates the tables because some of these acres represent double counting if they are a re-enrollment of a FY 2010-expiring contract. Table and chart footnotes explain whether the FY 2011 contracts are included or not.
- Overall, acreage under contract declined 1,177 acres since June as attrition exceeded new continuous signup contracts that started in July. The table on page 14 shows an increase in enrollment during July, because this table includes contracts that do not start until FY 2011.
- Early enrollments of the three new FWP practices have been recorded. There are 4,404 acres of aquaculture wetlands (CP40) under contract in Louisiana and Mississippi, and 13,349 acres of flooded prairie wetlands (CP41) under contract, primarily in the Dakotas (p. 22). These data do not include any acres that may be under FY 2011 contracts (see p. 3).
- Signup 38 (FY 2010 continuous signup) increased 22,920 acres in July to 296,615 acres. Last year signup 37 had enrolled 277,556 acres through July.
- FY 2009 enrollment ended at 33.72 million acres. Following the expiration of 2.79 million acres, FY 2010 began with 30.93 million acres under contract. Adding 367,000 acres under FY 2010 contracts approved since October 2009 left enrollment at the end of July at 31.30 million acres, a net decline of 2.42 million acres from September 2009 (p. 17).
- Contracts approved during the general signup (#39) recently announced will begin in FY 2011 and are expected to be loaded into the active contract file during the October-January time frame.

**General Signup.** Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

**Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up.** Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

**Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP).** Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 44 agreements in 33 States.

**Farmable Wetland Program (FWP).** Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through July 30, 2010, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct mis-coded data in the active contract files.

**Note:** Contracts re-enrolled under 2006's re-enrollment and extension offer (REX) are not considered to expire when the current contracts expire, because new contracts will begin immediately after expiration.
