## Laterality

Laterality is required for sites C65.9 and C66.9.

## Grade

*Note:* These guidelines pertain to the data item Grade. Refer to the <u>*Collaborative Stage Data Collection</u>* <u>*Manual*</u> for instructions on coding site-specific factors.</u>

Urothelial carcinomas are graded as either low grade or high grade according to the WHO/ISUP grading system. The WHO/ISUP grade is captured as a Site Specific Factor in the <u>Collaborative Stage Data</u> <u>Collection System</u>. Do **not** convert WHO/ISUP grade to the SEER code for grade.

Adenocarcinoma and Squamous Cell Carcinoma

- Grade 2 Moderately differentiated
- Grade 3 Poorly differentiated
