## **Corrections to Pediatric ARV Treatment Guidelines**

On November 5, 2012, corrections were made to the <u>Pediatric ARV Treatment Guidelines</u> (released November 1, 2012) to correct the following errors:

In <u>What's New in the Guidelines</u>? under *What Drugs to Start*, the phrase "oral granules" erroneously used to describe raltegravir has been removed.

In the <u>Appendix A</u> record for <u>raltegravir</u>, under <u>Pediatric Use</u>, the GM 12hr concentration sited has been changed from "13 nM" to ">33 nM." The statement now correctly reads:

- Dose selection was based upon achieving target PK parameters similar to those seen in adults: PK targets are geometric mean (GM) area under the curve of 14-25  $\mu$ Mxh and GM 12 h concentration >33 nM.
