PROPOSALS TO ESTABLISH SNAKE RIVER VALLEY VITICULTURAL AREA AND EXPAND ALEXANDER VALLEY VITICULTURAL AREA

Washington, D.D. – The Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) issued two notices of proposed rulemaking in today's Federal Register.

Notice No. 60 proposes to establish the 8,263-square mile "Snake River Valley" viticultural area in southwestern Idaho and southeastern Oregon.

Notice No. 61 proposes to expand the Alexander Valley viticultural area in Sonoma County, California, by 1,300 acres along its northwestern boundary line.

Written comments must be received on or before September 15, 2006.
