GENERAL RELEASE AND WAIVER

WHEREAS, I, Enrico Fermi, residing at 5327 University Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, acquired pursuant to the agreement by and between G. M. Giannini & Co., Inc. and Enrico Fermi, Edoardo Amaldi, Bruno Pontecorvo, Franco Rasetti, Emilio Segre, Oscar d'Agostino, Giulio Cesare Trabacchi, dated October 7, 1935, a one-eighth (1/8) beneficial interest in the subject matter of U. S. Patent Application S. N. 43,462 and U. S. Patent No. 2,206,634 which issued thereon on July 2, 1940, and have never sold, assigned, transferred, mortgaged or otherwise encumbered my beneficial interest, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, the G. M. Giannini & Co., Inc., as the owner of legal title to said U. S. Patent No. 2,206,634 has brought, on behalf of itself and of each of the beneficial owners of the patent, certain proceedings before the United States Atomic Energy Commission, Patent Compensation Board, identified as Dockets Nos. 2 and 11, and the attorneys for G. M. Giannini & Co., Inc. and the Office of the General Counsel have agreed that the above entitled proceedings shall be settled by the payment of the sum of \$300,000.00 by the United States Atomic Energy Commission to G. M. Giannini & Co., Inc., or as directed by it;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the moneys paid pursuant to the aforementioned settlement, the receipt of which is duly acknowledged, I do hereby remise and release and forever discharge The United States of America from any and all claims, actions, causes of actions, suits for damages whatsoever, including any and all claims for an award, reasonable royalty or just compensation under the Atomic Energy Act of 1946, which I now have or might have against the United States of America or any department or agency thereof, their officers, agents, servants or employees and contractors and their employees, arising out of any use or infringement of, or otherwise in respect of, any subject matter disclosed or claimed in U. S. Patent Application S. N. 43,462 and U. S. Patent No. 2,206,634 which issued thereon on July 2, 1940, any reissues or extensions thereof that may hereafter issue thereon, any corresponding foreign patent applications or patents, and any subject matter disclosed in the above entitled proceedings, Dockets Nos. 2 and 11; and

I do further waive any claim under the Atomic Energy Act of 1946 (P.L. 585)(35 USC 1612) as respects the subject matter of the above entitled proceedings Dockets Nos. 2 and 11.
