


One Army School System (OASS) Initiative (Phase IV ALC integration)

Goal - Transform The Army School System (TASS) to enable Soldiers to receive a standardized education from any Army school, regardless of component, and to optimize school capacity and usage NLT 1 Oct 15.

- CASCOM has 30 ALC courses w/25 in compliance
- RC POIs are not aligned with AC courses
- FY15 AC attends RC schools:
- 42A : 46 AC slots
- 92T: 70 AC slots




