We're writing on behalf of the Legal Services Association of Michigan (LSAM) to comment on the proposed rulemaking on termination, limited reductions in funding, recompetition, enforcement and the suspension procedures. LSAM's members are the thirteen largest civil legal services organizations in Michigan.* Our member organizations collectively provide legal services to low-income individuals and families in over 50,000 cases per year.

We support the positions and supporting arguments offered in the comments submitted to the LSC Board of Directors by the National Legal Aid and Defender Association (NLADA). We are troubled by the lack of clear standards and the resulting lack of due process. We continue to share the concerns expressed by NLADA that the proposed changes will have unintended consequences on our clients.

While we are appreciative of the efforts to date to consider previously-raised concerns, we encourage the continued dialogue with NLADA to ensure a fair process that will enhance, as opposed to impede, our ability to provide quality legal services to our client communities.
