CHART NAME: APPLICATIONS FOR IMMIGRATION BENEFITS


WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on applications and petitions received by USCIS for immigration benefits in July 2012. This chart excludes all data associated with the citizenship related applications.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Immigration application receipts decreased 6 percent compared to the number received in July 2011. July 2012 approvals increased by 8 percent, denials decreased by 2 percent, and pending increased by 4% compared to July 2011.

- Major volumes of pending applications at the end of July 2012 include: 640,955 I-130 immediate/all other petitions; 348,807 I-485 applications to adjust status; 184,501 I-90 green card renewals/replacements; 140,835 I-765 employment authorizations; 126,898 I-751 remove conditions spouse jointly/waive; 117,982 I-129 forms filed; 57462 I-131 travel document/advance parole.
