## CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS


**WHAT IT DISPLAYS:** The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of April 2012.

**WHAT IT SHOWS:** Naturalization receipts in April 2012 increased 16 percent when compared to April 2011, while approvals/oaths increased by 6 percent and denials increased 14percent.
