
CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS

WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of January 2012.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Naturalization receipts in January 2012 increased 9 percent when compared to January 2011, while approvals/oaths increased by 14 percent and denials increased 23percent.

The number of pending N-400 cases reached 308,512 in January 2012, an increase of 9 percent compared to the same month in fiscal year 2011.
