
## CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS

**WHAT IT DISPLAYS:** The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of February 2010.

**WHAT IT SHOWS:** Naturalization receipts in February 2010 increased 7 percent when compared to February 2009, while approvals/oaths decreased by 22 percent and denials decreased 50 percent.

## N-400 Naturalization Applications: Received, Approval/Oaths, and Pending

The number of pending N-400 cases reached 245,199 in February 2010, a decrease of 23 percent compared to the same month in fiscal year 2009.
