
CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS

WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of April 2010.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Naturalization receipts in April 2010 increased 22 percent when compared to April 2009, while approvals/oaths decreased by 16 percent and denials decreased 46 percent.

N-400 Naturalization Applications: Received, Approval/Oaths, and Pending

The number of pending N-400 cases reached 280,539 in April 2010, a decrease of 4 percent compared to the same month in fiscal year 2009.

¹ The Performance Analysis System (PAS) is the USCIS System of Record for capturing and reporting field office and service center performance data. The G-22.3 is the PAS data entry worksheet used to collect the monthly Naturalization statistics.
