
## CHART NAME: APPLICATIONS FOR IMMIGRATION BENEFITS

**WHAT IT DISPLAYS:** The below chart provides data on applications and petitions received by USCIS for immigration benefits in March 2011. This chart excludes all data associated with the citizenship related applications.

**WHAT IT SHOWS:** Immigration application receipts decreased 2 percent compared to the number received in March 2010. March 2011 approvals decreased by 5 percent, denials decreased by 17 percent, and pending increased less than 1% compared to March 2010.

Applications for Benefits: Received, Approved, and Pending

- Major receipt volumes in March 2011 include: 87,358 I-90 green card renewals/replacements; 79,788
  I-765 employment authorizations; 74,255 I-130 immediate/all other petitions; 48,260 I-485 applications to adjust status; 33,160 I-131 travel document/advance parole; 24,786 I-129 forms filed.
- Major volumes of pending applications at the end of March 2011 include: 483,373 I-130 immediate/all other petitions; 395,760 I-485 applications to adjust status; 267,088 I-90 green card renewals/replacements; 133,695 I-765 employment authorizations; 82,368 I-751 remove conditions spouse jointly/waive; 58,826 I-131 travel document/advance parole; 41,469 I-129 forms filed.
