
## CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS

**WHAT IT DISPLAYS:** The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of April 2011.

**WHAT IT SHOWS:** Naturalization receipts in April 2011 increased 6 percent when compared to April 2010, while approvals/oaths increased by 10 percent and denials decreased 1 percent.

The number of pending N-400 cases reached 329,404 in April 2011, an increase of 17 percent compared to the same month in fiscal year 2010.
