
## CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS

**WHAT IT DISPLAYS:** The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of March 2011.

**WHAT IT SHOWS:** Naturalization receipts in March 2011 increased 12 percent when compared to March 2010, while approvals/oaths increased by 4 percent and denials decreased 5 percent.

N-400 Naturalization Applications: Received, Approval/Oaths, and Pending

The number of pending N-400 cases reached 312,008 in March 2011, an increase of 19 percent compared to the same month in fiscal year 2010.
