CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS


WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of May 2011.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Naturalization receipts in May 2011 increased 3 percent when compared to May 2010, while approvals/oaths increased by 12 percent and denials increased 7 percent.
