U. S. Small Business Administration Semi-Annual Report on Disaster Contracting

Report on Contracting. Section 12091 (e) of Title XII, Subtitle B of the Food, Conservation and Energy Act of 2008 (P.L. 110-246), the Small Business Disaster Response and Loan Improvement Act of 2008, requires a report regarding federal contracts awarded as a result of major disasters.

Section 12091 / Paragraph (e) require SBA to:

- "(1) In General. Not later than 6 months after the date on which the President declares a major disaster, and every 6 months thereafter until the date that is 18 months after the date on which the major disaster was declared, the Administrator shall submit a report to the Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship of the Senate and to the Committee on Small Business of the House of Representatives regarding Federal contracts awarded as a result of that major disaster;
- (2) Contents. Each report submitted under paragraph (1) shall include-
 - (A) the total number of contracts awarded as a result of that major disaster;
 - (B) the total number of contracts awarded to small business concerns as a result of that major disaster;
 - (C) the total number of contracts awarded to women and minority-owned businesses as a result of that major disaster; and
 - (D) the total number of contracts awarded to local businesses as a result of that major disaster."

The following report covers SBA disaster operations beginning in July 2008 to June 2009.

(1) Total number of contracts awarded as a result of major disasters

Information on the number of contract actions reported as a result of major disasters is displayed by State, disaster, and Congressional District in Attachments (A, B, C, and D) appended hereto. Data for contract actions identified as related to a major disaster was extracted from the Federal Procurement Data System Next Generation (FPDS NG). A "contract action" as used herein is defined as a single action reported by a government contracting officer to award, modify, add or subtract funding, or terminate a contract. .

This data only covers federal disaster contracts awarded and does not include state contract awards which may have been funded by federal money from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and other agencies.

(2) Total number of contracts awarded to small business concerns as a result of that major disaster

The contract actions reported in attachments A through D reflect only prime contract actions processed for small businesses as reported in FPDS.

(3) The total number of contracts awarded to women and minority owned businesses as a result of that major disaster.

A summary of prime contract actions by State, major disaster, and Congressional District is included in Attachments A through D.

(4) The total number of contracts awarded to local businesses as a result of that major disaster.

A summary of prime contract actions by State, major disaster, and Congressional District is included in Attachments A through D. Frequently corporations are placed on contract by the Federal Government to provide materials and services for disasters in other areas of the United States and her territories. Contracting Officers reporting in FPDS consider a company as "local" if the work is being performed in the area (state, city or county) where the contract is awarded; not in the area where the declared disaster occurred.

(5) Additional information provided.

A summary of the value of contract actions awarded to small, women and minority-owned businesses is provided as Attachment (E). Negative values are highlighted in red. Negative number occurs when a contract action was awarded in a prior period, and unused funds are de-obligated during the reporting period, or the contract is altered in some way requiring a de-obligation of funds.

(6) Plans for reporting during the next calendar year.

The Small Business Administration proposes that one consolidated report for a major disasters reported in FPDS be submitted bi-annually in January and July for disasters within the previous six months.




